

RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION AT GENESIS FARM AND GARDENS

- 1. Alcohol consumption must be in accordance with Washington State law. If alcoholic beverages are served, the applicant must obtain a banquet permit from a Washington State Liquor store, and provide a licensed bartender during the entire time alcohol is being served. The licensed bartender must be hired by applicant from an approved list of bartenders provided by Genesis Farm and Gardens. The permit must be received by Genesis Farm and Gardens prior to the scheduled event. Failure to obtain the permit means that absolutely no alcohol will be allowed on the premises.**
- 2. Alcohol MAY NOT be served to guests or consumed by bridal party until AFTER the wedding ceremony. Forfeiture of event deposit is automatic, if violated.**
- 3. Consumption of alcohol by minors is prohibited by state law and will not be allowed at Genesis Farm and Gardens. If under age drinking is found to be a problem the function can be shut down. This right is reserved by the owner of the premises, any staff member of Genesis Farm and Gardens, and the licensed bartender. Automatic forfeiture of event deposit if violated.**
- 4. Beer may be served in bottles or cans only. Beer kegs and champagne fountains are not allowed.**
- 5. If alcohol is brought onto the property without the owners' knowledge, the event deposit will automatically be forfeited.**
- 6. If the bar has to close, alcohol will be taken by Genesis Farm and Gardens and not released until the next day.**
- 7. Applicant acknowledges and accepts all legal responsibility and liability for the consumption of alcohol by his/her guests.**
